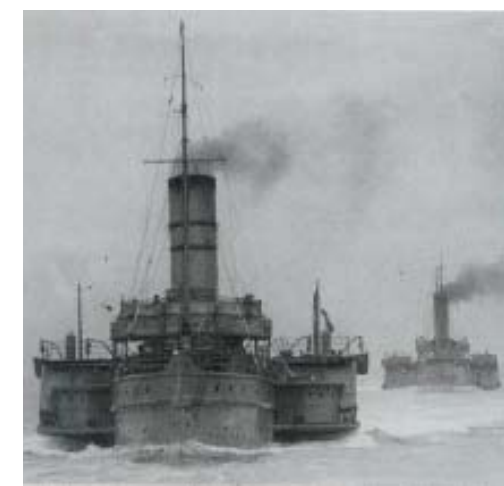

Waverley Commemorates the 70th Anniversary of Dunkirk



The Clyde Steamers have played a vital role in the defence of this country during World Wars I & II. An earlier Waverley served in both Wars and is shown here in April 1940 off the South Coast of England in the company of the Duchess of Fife. The Duchess of Fife returned to the Clyde, but on May 29, 1940, when returning with troops from the Dunkirk beaches, Waverley paid the supreme sacrifice. Plans to replace Waverley were made and A. & J. Inglis Ltd of Glasgow fulfilled the order. On October 2, 1946, the last Paddle Steamer to be built for the Clyde was launched - the name Waverley perpetuating the memory of the previous Waverley built in 1899 which was lost at Dunkirk. In 2010 a sailing by Waverley in each area will be nominated as a day to commemorate this Anniversary.
