Waverley is the last Sea-going Paddle Steamer in the World – magnificently restored with towering funnels, timber decks and gleaming varnish & brass. Built in 1947, she is a truly unique venue, British registered to carry 925 passengers. The ship boasts 2 comfortable lounge bars, a traditional tearoom, an observation suite, a restaurant and a souvenir shop. The famous steam engines are open for passengers to view.



Waverley's promenade deck is a fantastic viewing platform and the deck at elevated level can accommodate 100 guests.

We offer full catering and bar facilities and can arrange these to suit your specific requirements. **Waverley** has modern facilities with power, sound and communications systems. She can be decorated or branded with your company logos and corporate identity.

In 2003, **Waverley** completed the final phase of her £7m rebuild – restoring her to her original condition.

Restaurant

Waverley's Art Deco restaurant can comfortably seat 100 at any sitting. Located on the main deck, you can watch the scenery slip by as you enjoy your meal. The restaurant can provide anything from a snack to a 3 course meal, accompanied by a selection of wines. Our Catering Manager will work with you to ensure that the best possible menu is provided for your guests, or if you would prefer to eat buffet style, help you choose the selection best suited to your requirements.



Jeanie Deans Bar

This lounge can hold up to 200 people. There is an option to subdivide the room into smaller, private areas if required. The bar is fully stocked with wines, draught & bottled beer and spirits. We can, if you require serve a buffet in this room. Entertainment can also be provided.

Caledonia Tea Room

The Caledonia Tea room can hold up to 60 people and is an ideal venue for those extra special guests! Located on the Promenade Deck, it boasts windows down either side of the room. Tea, coffee and snacks are available and a bar service can be provided.



Observation lounge

The Observation Lounge is ideal for smaller groups. Accommodating 25 passengers, it is located on the promenade deck and boasts windows all around making it an ideal viewing platform. A mobile bar/catering service can be provided.

Lower Bar

The Lower Bar can hold up to 65 people for a reception. It is located just below the main deck and features a fully stocked bar.
